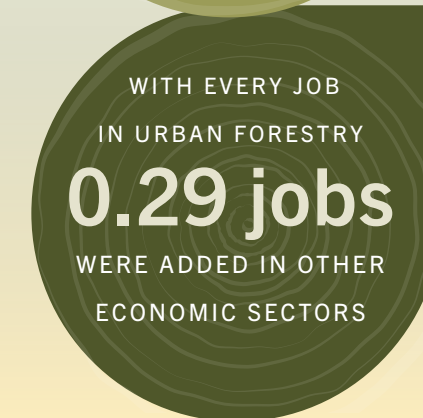

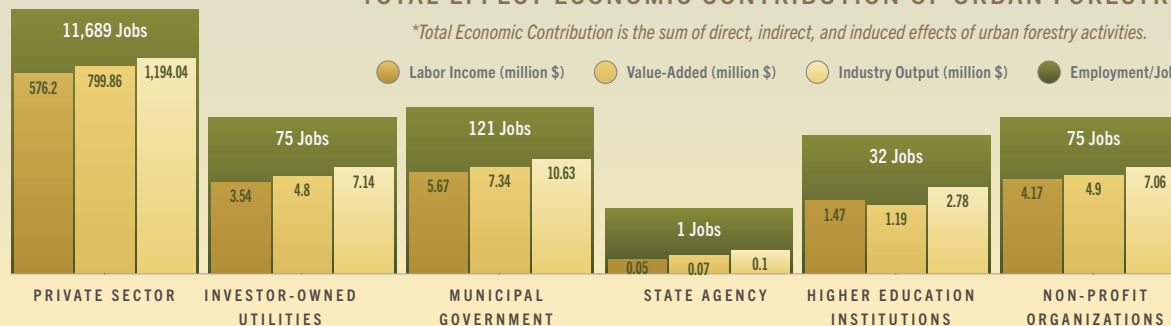

*Total Economic Contribution is the sum of direct, indirect, and induced effects of urban forestry activities.

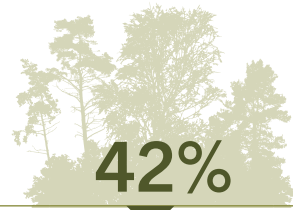
